Colby Wildlife Preserve	Rte 27 N 4.2 mi, right on River Rd 2.2 mi, Edgcomb. Sign, 4 car parking lot, kiosk.	Easy. 12 acres on Salt Marsh Cove, Damariscotta River.	0.7 mile loop			
Damariscove Island <i>Note: Sorry, no dogs on the island.</i>	6 mi out to sea from Boothbay Harbor in open ocean. Excellent tiny harbor at south end. Dock & 2 BRLT moorings. Summer caretakers. Dock or alternative use (kayaks) gravel beach on west shore.	Challenging. 210 acre historic island. Protected bird nesting area, island closed to dogs.	3 miles total			
Gregory Hiking Trail	Rte 27 N 1.2 mi, left at Monument onto Corey Lane .3 mi right on Barter Island Rd 1.8 mi, left on Hodgdon Isl. Rd .6 mi, Boothbay. Trail use has been granted by the owner. Sign, 4 car parking lot, kiosk.	Easy. 20 acres along Back River, 12 acres.	0.8 mile loop			
Hendricks Head Hiking Trail	Rte 27 S 4.8 mi, right at Dogfish Head Rd, left on Beach Rd .4 mi, Southport. Sign, at Hendricks Head beach, park at beach.	Easy. 12 acres.	0.5 mile in & out			
Indiantown Island	Sheepscot River, at northern end of Ebenecook Harbor. Dock at northwest corner, & mooring. Sign, kiosks. Stay on trail.	Moderate. 27 acres + 33 acres easement on privately owned southern half.	1.6 miles total			
Linekin Preserve	Rte 96 E 3.7 mi, East Boothbay. Sign, 4 car parking lot, kiosk.	Challenging. 137 wooded acres. Steep section down to the Damariscotta River.	2.9 miles total			
Lobster Cove Meadow Preserve	Rte 96 E .5 mi, right on Eastern Ave .1 mi, Boothbay Harbor. Kiosk & 6 car parking lot. Alternative: walk in at 163 Lobster Cove Rd. No sign, <u>no</u> parking.	Moderate. 47 acres, field, wetland, and woods. Bridge at south end (Lobster Cove) connects to "Indian Trail" and to Appalachee Preserve.	1.5 miles total			
Ovens Mouth East <i>Snowshoe</i>	Rte 27 N 2.9 mi, left on Adams Pond Rd .2 mi, right on Dover Rd 2.3 mi, Boothbay. Sign, 8 car parking lot, kiosk.	Easy. 60 acres, partially waterfront. Bridge at far (northern) end connects to Ovens Mouth West.	1.6 miles total			
Ovens Mouth West	Rte 27 N 2.9 mi, left on Adams Pond Rd .2 mi, right on Dover Rd 1.9 mi, left on Dover Cross Rd .3 mi, Boothbay. Sign, 4 car parking lot, kiosk.	Challenging. 86 acres. Bridge at far (northern) end connects to Ovens Mouth East	4 miles total			

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Penny Lake Preserve	Rte 27 N .1 mi, Boothbay Harbor, behind Chamber of Commerce. Sign, 6 car parking lot, kiosk. Accessible also from St Andrews Village on Emery Lane.	Easy. 29 acres + 25 acre easement. Field and woods. Penny Lake bridge.	1.5 miles total			
Pine Tree Preserve <i>Opening Summer 2010</i>	<i>Trail and parking opening summer 2010.</i> Boothbay Harbor. No sign, roadside parking. Alternative: 60 Oak Lawn Rd, Boothbay Harbor. 4 car parking. Climb hill to pond and to join trail.	Moderate. 140 acres with unmarked existing trails. Pond 1 mi to north end of trail.	1.1 mile loop			
Porter Preserve & Roberts Wharf	Rte 27 N 1.2 mi, left at Monument onto Corey Lane .3 mi right on Barter Island Rd 2.3 mi, left on Kimballtown Rd .5 mi, Barters Island, Boothbay. Signs. 8 car parking lot, kiosk. Boat access via dock at Roberts Wharf.	Easy. 23 wooded acres bordering Sheepscot River. Small shingle beach.	1.4 miles total			
River-Link Preserve <i>Opening Spring 2010</i>	<i>Trail and parking opening spring 2010.</i> Rte 27 N 7.1 mi, right on McKay Rd .9 mi, Edgecomb.	Easy. 80 acres. Connects to Schmid Preserve.	2 miles in & out			
Saunders Preserve	Rte 96 E .9 mi, left on Back Narrows Rd 2 .9 mi, right to Pleasant Cove, Boothbay. Sign, 3 car parking lot, kiosk.	Moderate. 22.5 acres, slopes down to Damariscotta River.	1.3 miles total			
Schoolhouse Pond Preserve <i>Skiing and bicycling</i>	Rte 27 N 1.2 mi, left at Monument onto Corey Lane .3 mi right on Barter Island Rd 1.9 mi, right on East Side Rd 2.0 mi, Barters Island, Boothbay. Also sign posted East Side Rd. Sign, 10 car parking lot, kiosk .	Moderate. 42 acres.	1.7 miles total			
Singing Meadows <i>Skiing/snowshoeing</i>	Rte 27 N 9.3 mi, left on Eddy Rd .4 mi, left on Cross Point Rd .3 mi, Edgecomb. Sign, 3 car parking lot, kiosk.	Easy. 16 acre field.	0.7 miles total			
Thorpe Preserve	Rte 27 S 2.2 mi, left on McKown Point Rd .3 mi, Boothbay Harbor. Small sign. 2 car parking near boat launching ramp. Privately owned land.	Challenging on Gut side. Easy on Harbor side. 4 acres, trail splits in 2 parcels on either side of town road. Small gravel beach on harbor side.	0.5 miles total			
Zak Preserve at Wildcat Creek <i>Skiing & snowshoeing</i>	Rte 27 N 5.3 mi, Boothbay. Sign, 20 car parking lot, kiosk.	Moderate. 208 acres, large open field, trail follows Wildcat Creek.	3.6 miles total			

BRLT properties are open for quiet, low impact activities. When visiting BRLT's properties, please observe the following rules:

- Overnight camping and fires are not allowed.
- Parties greater than 10 must obtain permission.
- Respect commercial working waterfront activities at Roberts Wharf and Damariscove Island.
- Commercial use is not permitted.

Keep dogs under control and carry out all litter. Mutt mitts are available at most kiosks. (Dogs are allowed on all preserves except Damariscove Island.)
