## A TRAIL CONNECTING THE SHEEPSCOT & DAMARISCOTTA RIVERS

The Church Property is a 104-acre preserve with a moderate .75-mile trail connecting to the town of Edgcomb's Schmid Preserve. The Church and Schmid properties are part of a larger network of conserved land called the River~Link system. River~Link provides a recreational trail, wildlife corridor, and greenway that connects the Sheepscot and Damariscotta Rivers.

The River~Link trail begins at Zak Preserve in Boothbay on its southern end and extends about 7 miles to its northern terminus in Newcastle at Dodge Point Preserve, managed by Coastal Rivers Conservation Trust. River~Link is a backcountry trail of moderate difficulty, crossing a network of public and private lands. Many hikers prefer to park at the Church Property to access the River~Link trails and car shuttles can be set up between the Church Property and Dodge Point or Zak Preserve.

**Directions to Church Property:**  
From the roundabout in Boothbay Center, travel north on Route 27 about 6 miles; turn right on McKay Road and proceed .1 mile. Church Property is on the right.
